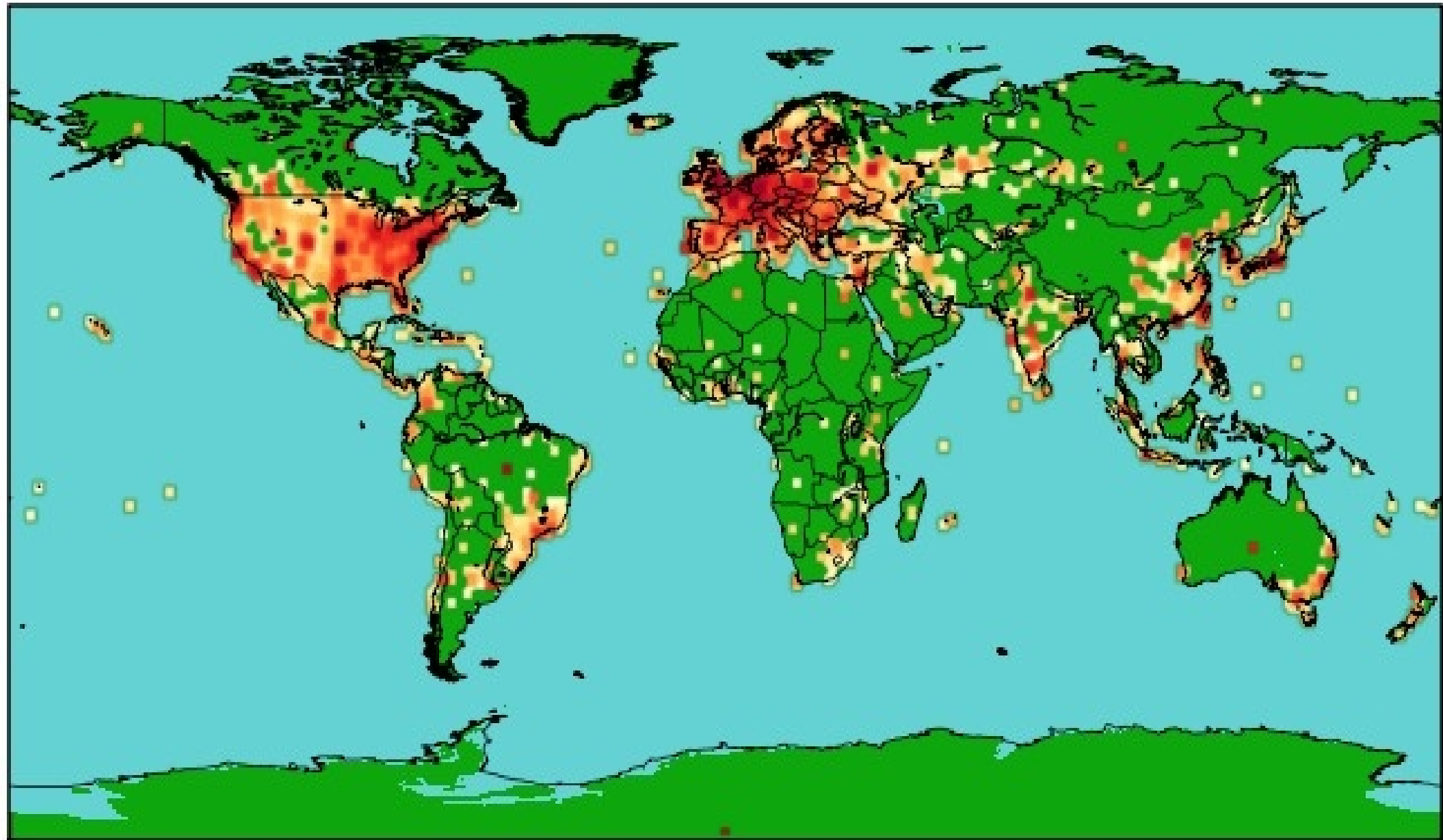

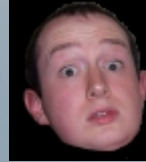
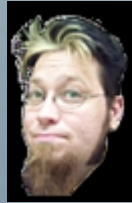

# How to Join?

---

You have to (step by step)

- Fill registration form
- Download Contributor License Agreement (CLA)
- Sign (gpg) CLA and send it back
- Add yourself to destination membership (for instance: Ambassadors, Art Work, etc...)
- Download Client Side Certificate
- Ask to a Fedora Member to be inserted into EditPage on the wiki
