To whom it may concern:

The Fedora Project is a Red Hat sponsored and community supported open source project. Its goal is to work with a global community of contributors to build a complete, general purpose operating system based on Linux, and built entirely from free and open source software. That operating system is called Fedora, and it is free for anyone to download, install, use, modify, and distribute.

The Fedora CDs and/or DVDs accompanying this letter contain copies of the Fedora operating system, which is made up entirely of software that is freely licensed, and which may be used and distributed free of charge and free of any royalties.

The value of the CDs and DVDs is therefore de minimis. For shipping and insurance purposes, we declare the value of each CD or DVD to be \$0.15 USD.

This media is not being imported for commercial purposes, and it will be given away free of charge. As such, we believe that no import duties should be imposed.
